DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR BARBADOS CITIZENSHIP APPLICATIONS UNDER SECTION 3(2) OF CONSTITUTION

The following documents are required for applications under Section 3(2) of the Constitution.

- (a) Birth Certificate;
- (b) If a Married Woman Marriage Certificate must be produced;
- (c) Four (4) passport size photographs one of which should be certified by a Justice of the Peace or Notary Public;
- (d) Application fee of three hundred (\$300.00) dollars;
- (e) Letters from school(s) attended in Barbados.

It should be noted that -

- (a) If name does not appear on Birth Certificate, a Baptism Certificate must also be produced;
- (b) In the event of any discrepancy in any of the names appearing on the documents required above, then an Affidavit must be submitted in order to clarify the same.
- P.S. Photo-copies of Certificates must be accompanied by the original Certificates.
